HONOURABLE MEMBERS FOR GASPEFOREWORD

The "YESTERDAY" of "GASPÉ OF YESTERDAY" implies memory, and time does play strange tricks with memory - particularly when the personalities and events under recall reach back in time some two hundred years. Members of Parliament that were household names among their fellow Gaspesian electors of past generations are fading into oblivion. Even their place in the time-frame of political representation has become, at best, somewhat shadowy.

In an effort to preserve and record this aspect of our Gaspesian heritage, "GASPE OF YESTERDAY" has attempted to search out and record, in chronological order, those Members elected by Gaspesians over the past two hundred years to represent their interests in the Provincial and Federal Parliaments. The present article will recall the names of these Members and present them in four divisions, viz:

- I. The original District of Gaspé and the Counties of Bonaventure and Gaspé until the Lower Canada Rebellion of 1837.
- II. The Province of Canada from the Union Act to Confederation.
- III. The Quebec Legislative Assembly from Confederation to the present.
- IV. The Canadian House of Commons from Confederation to the present.

As a logical sequel, it is proposed to supplement this article with biographical notes on the Members listed, including their respective political affiliations. For such project, as indeed for any article of this series, the contributions, comments and corrections of readers will be welcomed.

THE NEIGHBOURING COUNTY OF GASPÉ HAD THE RIGHT TO ELECT ONE MEMBER DURING THE YEARS 1830 - 1832; FROM THEN UNTIL 1838 IT COULD ELECT TWO (2) MEMBERS.]

[As a result of the Rebellion of 1837 in Lower Canada, the Constitution was suspended for more than two years by Act of the Parliament of Great Britain and the Assembly ceased to meet.

In January, 1838, Lord Durham was named to the post of Governor-General and Lord High Commissioner in Canada and given sweeping powers to deal with the Rebellion and to make recommendations for reform. His historic "REPORT ON THE AFFAIRS OF BRITISH NORTH AMERICA", was submitted to the British Government in January, 1839.

As a consequence of the "DURHAM REPORT" the Union Act of 1840 provided for a single House of Assembly for the Provinces of Lower and Upper Canada. In this new House of Assembly for the Province of Canada it was provided that the Gaspesian Counties of Bonaventure and Gaspé would have one member each.]

THE QUEBEC LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

CONFEDERATION IN 1867 CREATED A FEDERAL HOUSE OF COMMONS AND RESTORED PROVINCIAL LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLIES . THE NORMAL SITUATION WAS THAT THE COUNTIES OF BONAVENTURE AND GASPÉ WOULD EACH HAVE ONE FEDERAL AND ONE PROVINCIAL MEMBER EACH. BUT FOR A PERIOD OF YEARS, FROM 1867 to 1874, A "DOUBLE ELECTORAL MANDATE" WAS PERMITTED, THAT IS TO SAY THAT A MEMBER COULD BE BOTH A FEDERAL AND A PROVINCIAL REPRESENTATIVE. AS WILL BE SEEN THIS WAS THE CASE FOR THEODORE ROBITAILLE OF BONAVENTURE AND PIERRE FORTIN OF GASPÉ.

GASPÉ-NORTH COMPRISED THE TERRITORY BETWEEN CAP-CHAT AND L'ÉCHOUIERIE WITH EXTENSION INLAND TO INCLUDE MURDOCHVILLE. GASPÉ-SOUTH COMPRISED THE BALANCE OF THE FORMER COUNTY OF GASPÉ EXTENDING FROM RIVIÈRE-AU-RENARD TO NEWPORT ON BAY CHALEUR. SUCH DIVISION APPLIED FROM 1931 TO 1973]
