Ascah's Nationality - English

The Ascah Family is one of the first to settle in Gaspe under the British Rule. Richard Ascah born on March 5th 1724 at England, was a captain in Wolf's Army and took part in the capture of both Gaspe and Quebec. After the siege of Quebec he went to Halifax and married Christianna Millich born on December 31st 1735 of Duteh or German origin. He returned to Quebec and his first child a daughter (Hannah) was born April 8th 1763, the following summer Richard with his family arrived at Gaspe and settled at Peninsula, he was given 700 acres of land for his war services.

Old spelling of the name were AUSCHA and ASCHY.

The Ascah Family is divided into three sections and is separated by letters from A to C - section A is incomplet due to the records not available.
