Records show that the Grant family was residing in Nova Scotia in 1788 the time they came there and from where is not known.

William first member of the Grant family to settle in Gaspe, left his home in Parrsboro Nova Scotia at an early age and came to Gaspe about 1812 and settled in York on lot no. 18 land patented by the O'Hara and McCords. In his life time he had three homes destroyed by fire. The only member of the Grant family residing on the property to day is Archibold a grand son of William Grant.
