## Nelsons Nationality - Trish

Records whow that the Nelson family was residing in Nova Scotiin 1789. The family came there with the United Empire Loyalists.

At an early age James left his home in Nove Scotia and went to the state of Maine, from there he walked behind a team of oxen to the Gaspé Coast arriving in Shigawake in 1815. Upon his arrival there, James, a shoe-maker by trade opened one of the first Shoemakers shops on the Gaspé coast and made his home there.

In 1854, Thomas Fitzellan, a son of James left his home in Shigawake and came east on the coast and settled in Sunry Fank on Lot No: 19, land of his wife which came from the Patterson's. Thomas' old home which has been long demolished, was built on the hill about two acres from the swarp. The land is occupied today by Sydney and Thomas Nelson, great grandsons of Thomas Fitzellan.
