Palmer's Nationality - English

James, first member of the Palmer to settle in Gaspé, arrived around 1850 from Prince Edward Island, and settled in Wakeham.

He built a home on Lot No: 22, the land a Trade Deed of his wife Maria Patterson, Hugh O'Hara, the first owner of the land, sold it to John Eden, then John Eden sold the land to Edmond Patterson.

Maria Patterson and her brother, Edmond, made a Trade Deed. Maria Patterson traded her land in Sunny Bank for Edmond Patterson's land in Wakeham.

The old home today is around 105 years old and is occupied by Charlie Palmer, a grandson of James. The land in Sunny Bank involved in the above trade is owned today by Mrs. Joseph Patterson of Sandy Beach and Philip Patterson of Sunny Bank.
