Records show that the Tripp's was residing in Nova Scotia in 1779 the time of their arrival there is unknown.

Samuel first member of the family to settle in Gaspe arrived in 1810 from Nova Scotia. He settled in Wakeham on lot no. 9 his land was an O'Hara sale.

A few years ago Harold Mullin Jr. used some lumber to build his home that was taken from Samuel's old home that he built in 1810.

Harold Mullin Jr. and his brother Samuel Great Grand sons of Samuel Tripp occupies the center part of the Tripps land site of the old homestead. The Vibert family the western part and the eastern is occupied by several families.

Down through the years the Tripp Family has disappeared and to day Alfred is the only known member of the family living. He resides in the old home of the Marquand at Wakeham.
