Know all Men by these Presents, that We Isaac
Archdeacon of the Dean and Aisle of the Church of London
in the County of Middlesex

are held and firmly bound unto the Right Reverend Father in God William
by Divine Provision, Lord Bishop of London, in two hundred Pounds of good and lawful
Money of Great Britain, to be paid to the said Right Reverend Father, or to his certain
Attorney, his Executors, Administrators or Assigns: the which Payment and bond to
be void, in things aforesaid, and each of us, by writing, for the whole, any, and each of
our Heirs, Executors and Assigns forever, truly by these Presents. Witness our
Seal. Dated the 15th of March 1766
in the Year of our Lord and King's Majesty George the Third the first year

THE Condition of this Obligation is such that if there shall
not hereafter appear any lawful Let or Impediment, by reason
of any Pre-contract, Consanguinity, Affinity or any other just
Cause whatsoever, but that Isaac Archdeacon of the Dean and
Aisle of the Church of London

may lawfully marry together; and that there is not any Suit
depending before any Judge Ecclesiastical or Civil, for or concern-
ing any such Precontract; and that the Consent of the Parents
or others the Governors of the said Parties be thereunto first had
and obtained, and that they cause their said Marriage to be
openly solemnized in the Face of the Parish Church of

London
between the Hours of Eight and Twelve in the Forenoon, and
do and shall save harmless and keep indemnified the above-
named Lord Bishop, his Commissary, his Surrogates, and all
other his Officers and Successors in Offices, for and concerning
the Premises, then this Obligation to be void or else in force.
